ORDINANCE NUMBER 2049

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WATER BILL COLLECTION POLICIES WITHIN THE CITY OF PLEASANTON, KANSAS

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PLEASANTON, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 15-110, Chapter 15, Article One, of the Code of the City of Pleasanton, Kansas is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"15-110 LATE PAYMENT. Water bills are due on the 10th of the month. If the full amount is not paid by the close of business on the 10th, or should the 10th fall on a weekend or holiday, by the close of business on the next business day, late fees of 10% will be assessed at the close of business and applied to the customer's account. Customers who have failed to pay a water bill by the 21st day of the month, or who, on the 21st day of the month, have unpaid water bills for previous months, will have their water service disconnected; except, however, if, prior to the 21st day of the month, such customer notifies the Water Clerk of the customer's inability to pay such bill by the 21st, water service will be continued until the last day of the month or, if the last day of the month falls on a Friday or weekend, the first Monday following the last day of the month. If the remainder of the overdue bill is not paid by that date, water service will be discontinued until all charges, including any applicable reconnection fees, are brought current."

- Section 2. The City Clerk is directed to integrate this amended section into the Code of the City of Pleasanton, Kansas.
- Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon its approval, the publication of a summary hereof in the official newspaper of the city of Pleasanton, and the publication of the entire ordinance for at least one week on the official website of the City of Pleasanton.
