CALL HEARING TO ORDER:

- A. CALL HEARING TO ORDER:** Mayor Frisbie called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.
- B. PUBLIC COMMENT:** Janet Kleweno 1350 Walnut Street. She requested a copy of the budget from Erica and never received one. She asked why we are raising the budget 2.5 mills in the streets department. She asked whether we have plans for the repairs to the streets. Kern explained that there are plans to repair portions of Ash with cold patch and tack oil. Kern explained much of the struggles with the budget and how we have been handed debt when we first came to city hall and now, we are just trying to pay off debt to get ahead. Chris Ellis stated he is all for fixing roads, but we must have a good base so doing overlay is not the answer.
